Dear Student/Family,

Thank you for indicating what equipment you will need to rent or buy through the Alzar School. We will use this information to help you get outfitted for your semester at the Alzar School. Hopefully, we can save you money and ensure that you end up with quality equipment. Please note that the school wants to make sure you end up in the right equipment to be prepared and comfortable. The entire packing list is included here. Items that the school sells and/or rents have check boxes next to them for you to indicate your request.

For items you have elected to rent from the Alzar School, your student account will be charged. Students are responsible for taking care of rented items. Any damage beyond normal wear and tear will be charged to their student account. Lost items will be replaced at the student's expense. For items you would like to purchase, we will send you an invoice and these purchases must be paid for separate from the student expense account. We have indicated rental prices and APPROXIMATE purchase prices on this sheet. Please note that purchase prices may vary considerably, and that these are just estimates. We offer the purchases as a service to our families to help you, but we have little control over the prices from retailers.

ALL PURCHASES AND RENTALS MUST BE REQUESTED BY JULY 1 TO GET EQUIPMENT FROM ALZAR SCHOOL FOR THE FALL SEMESTER AND BY OCTOBER 1 FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER!!!

Remember, any items that you indicated that you have or will obtain independently before the start of the semester need to come with you to campus. If you arrive without an item, or if an item does not meet the standards required by the Alzar School, we will use your student account to purchase the item, with an additional 5% procurement fee.

WE RECOMMEND YOU MAKE A COPY OF THIS COMPLETED FORM FOR YOUR RECORDS. That way, you know what you should pack, and what you can expect to be waiting for you when you arrive at Alzar School. By our signatures below, we are acknowledging that we will bring all of the items we have indicated "Bring" for, and leave all items at home that we have indicated "I will not bring." Additionally, we understand that we will be sent an invoice for the items we have marked "Buy" and the student account will be billed for the "Rent" items. We also understand that damage to rental items, beyond normal wear and tear, will be result in fees collected from the student account. We understand that if the student arrives without an item, or if an item does not meet the standards required by the Alzar School, the student account will be used to purchase the item, with an additional 5% procurement fee.
